1. Entries close Monday, May 6, 2024, at 9am
2. All Led Steers must be MSA Registered and Each vendor will be required to gain MSA producer registration and be accompanied by an MSA v-dec.
3. Led Steers to be presented for weighing and mouthing between the designated times Wednesday 22nd of May 2024
4. The committee reserves the right to reject any entry or inferior steers
5. Nose rings are not to be removed- Steers will be disqualified if nose rings are removed
6. Only polled (no scurs) & cleanly dehorned (not tipped) steers will be accepted in the competition
7. Fixed nose rings must be used and correctly secured, no grips or clips
8. Carcasses processed at The Casino Food Co-op and judged using ABCAS (Australian Beef Carcass Appraisal System).
9. HGP treated cattle will not be accepted in led steer events
10. Committee reserve the right to restrict number of entries per competitor to ensure the high standard of competition
11. Exhibitors must have public liability insurance extended to include attendance at Casino Beef Week. A copy of the Certificate of Currency must accompany entry form. A minimum cover of \$10million is required
12. National Vendor Declaration (also any other livestock forms which may be required at the time) must be given to Auctioneer prior to weighing - not to the Beef Week office. NLIS Tags required.
13. The exhibitor accepts all risks and liability for any type of injury, loss or damage whether or not such damage is caused or contributed to by negligence omission or acts on the part of the organiser its agents its employees, volunteers or others participating in Beef Week.
14. Exhibitors will not under any circumstance, hold the Casino Beef Week committee responsible for their loss or mis-delivery of livestock, or any damage thereto.
15. Steers will be sold c/kg carcass weight - not live weight.

Stud Cattle - Conditions of Entry

1. Exhibits must be registered or eligible for registration in their respective Society Herd Book
2. Entries close Monday, May 6, 2024, at 9am
3. All ages to be taken from and including 1st May 2024
4. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. All exhibits from a partnership must be bona fide property of the firm exhibiting same, and no animal owned by an individual member of the firm will be eligible for a prize unless exhibited in his/her name.
5. All cattle entered in stud classes must be tractable and must be led into the parade ring. Stewards reserve the right to have any animal removed from the judging ring or other areas, if in their opinion, such animal is classed as dangerous, intractable or disadvantaging other exhibits.
6. Stud grooms are required to wear dustcoats or Breed Uniform. All animals must wear neck card around their neck or attached to the exhibitor. Cards to be collected at scale area.
7. Cattle less than 18 months must not show any permanent teeth.
8. The judge has the right to refuse allocation of prizes.
9. All animals must wear a nose ring or a nose grip and chin chain, (bulls over 12mths must be ringed.)
10. The committee may split classes if necessary.
11. Exhibitors must have public liability Insurance extend to include attendance at Casino Beef Week. Photocopy Public liability or a Certificate of Currency to accompany entry form. Minimum cover of \$10 million is required.
12. The committee reserves the right to restrict the number of entries
13. All entries to have neck collars
14. Cattle in the street must be in the control of owner or representative at all times.
15. Cows in the Stud Beef Classes three years and over must be in calf or showing signs of having been a breeder.
16. The winner of each class will be eligible for champion classes.
17. If doubt arises in the mind of the judge or judges, in any class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the chief steward for consideration.
18. Attention is drawn to the fact that all calves paraded with their mothers must not be more than 8 months of age.
19. All cattle must be made available for inspection at any time to persons nominated by the Beef Week Committee.
20. Exhibitors will not under any circumstance, hold the Casino Beef Week committee responsible for their loss or mis-delivery of livestock, or any damage thereto.
21. Exhibitors should be aware that animals at foot that are entering in a calf class cannot be shown on the dam as a cow and calf unit. Similarly, any animal shown on the dam cannot be entered in the calf class.
22. Stud Cattle must be tied up in the designated stud cattle area.
23. All bulls to be weighed Saturday morning between 6.30am- 7.30am
24. By entering you acknowledge that in the course of the event, photographs, images or film may be taken of yourself, either alone or in group shots with others.
